## HOW DO YOU GET A LICENSE?

- Work at least four of the last ten years in a building trade, as a journeyman or a supervisor
  - Apprenticeship programs, technical training, and college courses can count toward the four-year total
- Submit application with SSN or ITIN and fee to the Contractors State License Board (CSLB), certifying your experience
- Get fingerprinted for background check
- Take two computer exams, one on law & business management, and the other on your trade, at a CSLB test center
- After you pass the exams:
  - Get a license bond, and workers compensation insurance if you have employees
  - Pay license fee to CSLB
  - Take open-book CSLB asbestos test

## WHY GET A LICENSE?

- Legally take on jobs over \$500
- Advertise as a licensed contractor
- Bid on state and local government projects, and those financed by banks, S&Ls, and insurance companies
- Join builders' exchanges and contractors' associations, which offer job lists and group insurance rates
